主旨：有關加州大學爾灣分校（University of California at Irvine，
簡稱UCI）邀請我4所頂尖大學參與楊信獎學金計畫合作案，詳如說
明，敬請鑒察轉知。

說明：

- 一、行政院政務顧問楊信先生在美所設立之「楊信家族基金會」（J. Yang & Family Foundation），在本組協助下重新規劃「楊信獎學金計畫」（J. Yang Scholarships），同時擴大獎助金額，以鼓勵美國大學積極招收臺灣學子赴美就學，並與臺灣各大學進行合作，為在該學府就讀或任教的師生，提供赴臺灣進行教育交流及活動，或在校內推動臺灣相關研究的獎助機會，雙向培育臺灣及美國優秀人才，促進臺美學術及教育交流，以發揮基金會最大的獎助能量及效益。本獎學金計畫自107年8月起，由本組協助擬定簡章、徵求及審查計畫書、決定獎助金額、洽談捐贈協議及辦理捐贈儀式等，歷

時一年完成，總計捐贈包括UCI等5所位於南加州之頂尖學府5年共550萬美元。

二、UCI成立於1965年，設有222個學位課程，目前學生數3.6萬名，該校107學年計有臺灣留學生280名，包括166名大學部學生、114名研究生。在甫公布之2020年《美國新聞與世界報導》最佳大學排行中，該校名列第36名，單以公立大學而論，排行第9。所獲楊信獎學金獎助為期5年，每年20萬美元；其中用於臺灣學生來美就學經費，佔76%；而UCI學生赴臺學習和教授雙向講學及交流經費，佔24%。

三、該校以鈞部最新一期高教深耕計畫中核定全球鏈結（Global Taiwan）全校型國際競爭學校為執行對象，為我國學子創造到UCI就讀，以及UCI學生到4校學習和教授雙向合作交流的機遇，全數6項子計畫，受益人數可達百人。項目包括：

（一）研究生獎助計畫（J. Yang Graduate Fellowships）5年5名：設立每年1名7萬美元的研究生獎學金，提供即將入學該校資訊與計算機科學學院（ICS）碩士或博士班的研究生，待遇包括全額學雜費、生活津貼等。第二年起，ICS規劃經由學校的獎助管道，提供受獎生其餘3至4年的財務支持。

（二）研修獎助計畫（J. Yang Undergraduate Study Abroad Awards）5年5名：本項獎助將提供每年1名來自4校的大學部學生，在UCI交換研修一學年的費用，用於支付學雜費等開銷，且不限於特定專業或學院。

（三）大學部獎助計畫（J. Yang Scholarships）5年20名：設立每年提

供4名大學部獎助計畫，自新生或轉學生中甄選受獎生提供資助，以幫助他們在UCI就學期間減輕學費負擔。

(四)暑期赴臺研習獎助計畫 (J. Yang Summer Abroad Awards) 5年50名：本項獎助每年為10名UCI大學部學生或研究生於暑期赴臺進行為期4週研究和教育活動的機會。獎助用於支付機票、餐飲、交通、旅遊保險、食宿等，學生將自行負擔暑期學費。

(五)教授赴臺獎助計畫 (J. Yang Travel Awards for Faculty) 5年10名：每年提供2名UCI教授帶領學生前往合作學校訪問4週，進行講學、與學生小組研討及演講的機會。

(六)臺灣教授獎助計畫 (J. Yang Faculty Awards) 5年10名：每年UCI將邀請2名來自4校的教授到校訪問2週，獎助將用於提供機票和住宿相關開銷，以進行相互有益的知識共享、演講活動及會議，並與學生互動及文化交流的機會。

四、請鈞部函知4校積極與UCI洽商開發合作機會，並鼓勵校內師生針對相關獎助推薦優秀人選，踴躍申請，藉由此筆善款，進一步強化臺美交流及發展，提升師生國際競爭力，並深化與UCI合作關係。檢附該校所製簡介及宣傳單（含各計畫項目校內聯絡資訊）2份，UCI歡迎各校直接洽詢，倘需本組從中協助，可逕洽本組藍先茜組長（rebecca@mail.moe.gov.tw）。
